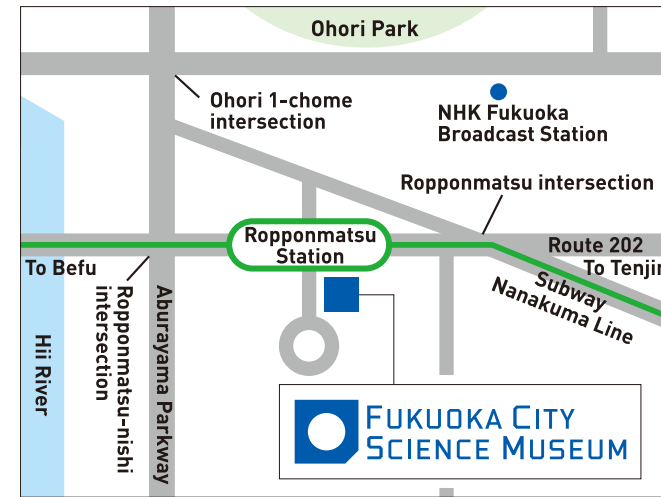
Message from the Honorary Director of the Museum

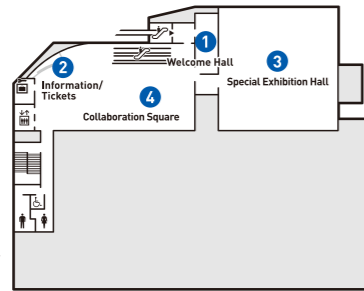

Space Learn through hands-on exhibits about the Earth, seeing from various aspects, and about the vastness of space.

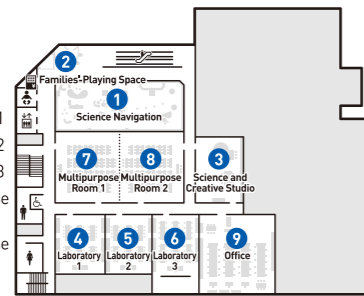


Future Use the power of science to create a new star and think about our own future.

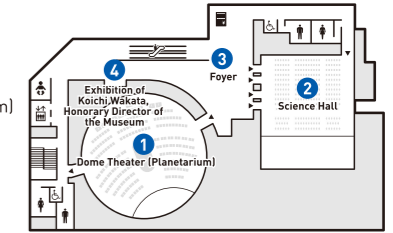

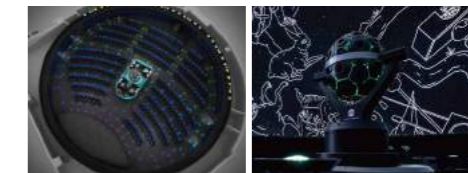

|| Top Class of Dome Theater (Planetarium) in Kyushu

Enjoy images with rich presence utilizing a cutting-edge optical projector which recreate the starry sky incredibly close to nature, and high-resolution (8K equivalent) digital projectors.



The Dome Theater has an environment that allows for comfortable viewing; the dome boasts a radius of 25 m, and the 220 seats are arranged spaciouly.



|| Science Hall

Equipped with stage, sound and lighting systems, equipment, and a 4K projector system, the 300-seat hall can be used for holding various events including lectures, seminars, and theatrical performances.
